CAR MAGNATE'S AUNT DIES AT 86 - Mrs. Ellen Bond McLaughlin⁽¹⁾ Oshawa Resident since 1906; Was Active Member of St. Andrew's Church - Funeral on Tuesday - Oshawa, June 11 (Special) - Mrs. Ellen Bond McLaughlin wellknown and respected resident of Oshawa for the past thirty-three years and an aunt of R. S. and G. W. McLaughlin died yesterday afternoon in her eighty-seventh year. She has been in failing health the past six months. Born at Emsfield of pioneer stock, Mrs. McLaughlin moved to the McLaughlin homestead at Tyrone, seven miles north of Bomanville, following her marriage to the late William McLaughlin, a brother of Robert, founder of the McLaughlin Carriage Company. William McLaughlin⁽²⁾ died in 1904 and two years later Mrs. McLaughlin moved to Oshawa, taking up residence at 44 Brock Street East. Of sunny disposition, she was widely esteemed by a wide circle of friends. She was an active member of St. Andrew's Presbyterian Church. Surviving are three sons and three daughters, Mrs. Milton Werry and Miss Florence, both of Oshawa, and Mrs. Harvey Cook, Toronto, and Albert, Frank and Douglas all of Oshawa. There are also three sisters and two brothers, Mrs. Letitia Morphy and Mrs. Bessie Braund both of Oshawa, and Mrs. Ida Trull, Hampton, and Fred Bond, Torrington Conn., and Amos Bond , Rowland, Man. The funeral will be held Tuesday from the family residence to Bomanville Cemetery.

Morphy, Andrew [c.1856-1931

In Oshawa, on Wednesday, January 23th, 1931, Andrew Morphy, beloved husband of Letitia Bond, in his 76th. year. Funeral from the family residence, 315Mary St., on Friday, January 30th. Dervice at 2:00 p.m. Interment Union cemetery. Mrs. Andrew Morphy ---- Resident of Oshawa for the past thirty eight years, Mrs. Letitia Morphy, widow of the late Andrew Morphy, died at half past five o'clock on Sunday morning, May 23rd at the residence of her daughter Mrs. W. Crossman of 315 Mary Street, where the deceased had lived for nearly a quarter of a century. Four Daughter live in Oshawa; Mrs. J. McMaster (Maude) of Alma street, Mrs. C Dewell (Mable) of Kingdale ave., Mrs. F. Gusscott)Alma) of Golf St. amd Mrs. William Crossman (Pearl) of Mary st.. One brother, Amos Bond, of Rloland Mam., and two sisters, Mrs. Bessie Braund of Edmonton, Albert (formerly of Oshawa) and Mrs. Ida Trull of Hampton also survive. 


